
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 240

Hymenoptera: Ichneumonidae

Eurypterna cremieri (Romand, 1838). Bohemia centr., Nižbor, Vůznice National Nature Reserve (5949), 6.ix.-9.x.1994, 1 ♂, 1 ♀, in a Malaise trap, J. Macek lgt. et det., coll. National Museum Praha. In Central Europe so far known only from Austria and Germany (Achterberg 1999). A record from the former Czechoslovakia in Achterberg (1999) was based on a misinterpreted note in the key by Bouček & Starý (1957) (C. van Achterberg, pers. comm.). New species for the Czech Republic.

Hybrizon pilialatus Tobias, 1988. Bohemia centr., Deštná env. (5452-53), 22.ix.2005, 1 ♀, K. Holý lgt., det. et coll. Known from Bulgaria, Germany, Italy, and European Russia (Achterberg 1999). New species for the Czech Republic.
