**FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC - 251**

**Lepidoptera:****Micropterigidae**

*Micropterix mansuetella* Zeller, 1844. Moravia bor. or., Kotvice Nature Reserve near Studénka (6274), 240 m a. s. l., 11.v.2007, 1 ♂, at light, 12.v.2007, 2 ♂♂, 11 ♀♀, on flowers of *Carex brizoides*, J. Sitek lgt., det. et coll. Known from many countries of Europe including all neighbouring the Czech Republic (Karsholt 2007). New species for the Czech Republic.

**Tineidae**

*Monopis fenestratella* (Heyden, 1863). Moravia or., Hůrka u Hranic National Nature Reserve (6472), 350 m a. s. l., 20.v.2007, 1 ♀, at light, J. Sitek lgt., det. et coll.; Moravia mer., Lanžhot – Soutok (7367), 150 m a. s. l., 27.v.2008, 1 ♂, at light, J. Liška lgt., det. et coll. Known from northern, western and central Europe (Germany, Austria, Slovakia, and Hungary) and Ukraine (Gaedike 2007). New species for the Czech Republic.

**Oecophoridae**

*Schiffermuelleria grandis* (Desvignes, 1842). Moravia mer. or., Bílé Karpaty Mts., Javořina National Nature Reserve (7172), 890 m a.s.l., 29.iv.2007 probably pupa, 1 ♂ emerged 12.v.2007 from a fallen and rotten beech branch, J. Ch. Vávra lgt., J. Sitek det. et coll. Occurs in highlands and mountain areas of Britain, France, northern Italy, Germany, Switzerland, Austria, Slovakia, Hungary, and Romania (Tokár et al. 2005). Only one record from Teplice was published from Bohemia (Zimmermann 1943). Confirmation of the occurrence in the Czech Republic after 66 years and a new species for Moravia.

**Gelechiidae**

*Chilopselaphus balneariellus* Chrétien, 1907. Moravia mer., Pouzdřany (7065), 280 m a.s.l., 10.v.1993, 1 ♂, A. Laštůvka lgt., J. Liška det. et coll., 14.vi.2007, 1 ♂, at light, J. Sitek lgt., det. et coll. Recorded from several localities in southern France, Austria, Slovakia, Hungary, and Ukraine (Elsner et al. 1999, Karsholt 2007). New species for the Czech Republic.

**Tortricidae**

*Epiblema cnicicolanum* (Zeller, 1847). Moravia mer., Terasy u Ječmeniště near Znojmo (7262), 270 m a.s.l., 8.vi.2007, 1 ♂, at light, J. Sitek lgt., det. et coll. Known from western, southern and central Europe (Austria, Slovakia, and Hungary) and Finland (Aarvik 2007). New species for the Czech Republic.
