
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 261

Coleoptera: Nitidulidae

Carpophilus quadrisignatus Erichson, 1843. Moravia mer., Klentnice (7165), enclosure, 3.v.2008, 7 spec. on oozing sap of an oak stump, R. Szopa leg., J. Jelínek det., coll. R. Szopa and National Museum, Praha. Originally almost certainly a Mediterranean species (Hisamatsu 1963), nowadays as invasive species acclimatized throughout southern Europe and reaching northwards to southern part of central France, southern Germany, Austria, Hungary, Slovakia and southern Poland (Audisio 1993). Further known from the Arabian Peninsula, Macaronesia and Africa south of Sahara. New species for the Czech Republic.
