**FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 263**

**Coleoptera: Rhysodidae**

*Omoglymmius germari* (Ganglbauer, 1891). Moravia mer., Břeclav – Pohansko, Cahnov National Nature Reserve (7267), 17.v.2008, 1 ♀ on notched surface of oak log stored on roadside stack, R. Weigler lgt., det. et coll. Widespread throughout Europe, known from Azerbaijan, Armenia, Austria, Bulgaria, France, Georgia, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Moldavia, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Russia (Southern European Territory), and Ukraine; in Asia known only from Iran and Turkey (Bell 2003). This species was not mentioned from the Czech Republic in the checklist of Czechoslovak beetles (Pulpán & Hůrka 1993). New species for the Czech Republic.
