Coleoptera: Cryptophagidae

Krásenský (Chomutov) et P. Štourač; Moravia mer., Lednice (7166-67), 29.x.2002, 1 spec., sifted from various organic substrates, L. Mazal lgt., P. Průdek det., coll. O. Nakládal.; Moravia mer., Břeclav env., Pohansko (7267), 1.viii.2007, 6 spec.; 28.viii.2007, 3 spec.; 9.x.2007, 5 spec.; 11.iii.2008, 1 spec.; 22.iv.2008, 4 spec., all sifted from old hay, R. Fornůsek lgt., det. et coll.; Moravia mer., Čejč env., Špidlák hill (7067), 31.iii.2008, 1 spec., sifted from old hay, R. Fornůsek lgt., det. et coll. Cosmopolitan species known in Central Europe from Hungary (Merkl 2004), Slovakia (Majzlan 2000), Austria, and Germany (Johnson et al. 2007). It was not listed from the Czech Republic in the check-list of Czechoslovak beetles (Reška & Jelínek 1993) but was mentioned without further details in the Catalogue of Palaearctic Coleoptera (Johnson et al. 2007). First detailed records from the Czech Republic.
