
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 266

Coleoptera: Malachiidae

Clanoptilus affinis (Ménétriés, 1832). Moravia mer., Pavlovské kopce hills (7165-66): without concrete locality data, vi.1928, 1 ♂, A. Hoffer lgt.; 13.vi.1934, 6 ♀♀, O. Kodym lgt.; Pálava (7165), 18.v.1984, 1 ♀, J. Macek lgt.; Divčí hrad nr. Pavlov (7165), 6.-7.vii.2004, 1 ♀, L. Blažej lgt., all V. Švihla det., coll. National Museum (Praha); Pálava (7165), 23.v.1992, 2 ♂♂ 5 ♀♀, J. Kobylák lgt., V. Švihla det., coll. Jihomoravské muzeum (Znojmo) and National Museum (Praha). Distribution: Spain, France, Italy, Switzerland, Austria, Poland, Slovakia, Hungary, Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Macedonia, Bulgaria, Greece, European Turkey, Ukraine, Russia, “Caucasus”, Iran, “Turkestan”, China: Xizang (Mayor 2007); specimens in the National Museum (Praha) also from Yugoslavia, Asian Turkey, Russia: Caucasus, Tuva, Buryatia, Primorye; Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan (unpublished data). Fleischer (1927-1930) reported this species from Moravia without concrete data. However, no voucher specimens were known and its presence in Moravia was therefore considered questionable in the list of Czechoslovak beetles (Švihla 1993). Since then both historical and recent Moravian specimens have become available. Confirmation of occurrence in the Czech Republic.
