
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 314

Coleoptera: Dytiscidae

Agabus (Gaurodytes) didymus (Olivier, 1795). Moravia bor., Skorošice env., Petrovický stream (5668c), 16.iv.2011, 1 ♂, in shallow stream pool with a sandy bottom overgrown by European Speedwell (*Veronica beccabunga*), R. Gabriš leg., det. et coll. Mediterranean species reaching Great Britain, north-western Germany, and Poland in the north (Nilsson & Holmen 1995). In the Czech Republic rare recently in Bohemia, doubtful occurrence in Moravia, only based on a few old imprecisely localized specimens (Boukal et al. 2007). Confirmed recent occurrence in Moravia.
