**FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 316**

**Coleoptera: Dermestidae**

*Anthrenocerus australis* (Hope, 1843). Bohemia centr., Mladá Boleslav (5555), iii.2011, 1 ♂, found on a windowsill in a house together with *Anthrenus* (*Nathrenus*) *verbasci* (Linnaeus, 1767) and *Attagenus smirnovi* Zhantiev, 1973, R. Mucska lgt., det. et coll., J. Háva revid. According to Háva (2007, 2011) the species is known from Australia (including Tasmania), New Zealand, Papua New Guinea and as introduced species from U.S.A, Europe: Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Britain, France, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands and Switzerland. From the Czech Republic known only from Moravia (Vávra 2006). New species for Bohemia.
